NOTIFICATION

No. MPP-F(5)-22/2013-I Dated : Shimla-2, the 28th June, 2016.

Whereas, the Central Electricity Authority (CEA) constituted under Section 70 of The Electricity Act, 2003, in exercise of its power conferred under Sub-section 177 read with the Section 53 of the Electricity Act, 2003, has framed Central Electricity Authority (Measures Relating to Safety and Electricity Supply) Regulations, 2010 as amended by the Central Electricity Authority (Measures Relating to Safety and Electric Supply) (Amendment) Regulations, 2015 (hereinafter referred as Central Electricity Authority Regulations): and

Whereas, in terms of the provisions contained in Regulations 2, 5A, 30 and 43 of the Central Electricity Authority Regulations, the appropriate Government is empowered to notify the “**Chartered Electricity Safety Engineer**” and the “Notified Voltage”.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Regulations 2, 5A, Sub-Regulations (2) to (5) of Regulation 30 and Sub-Regulations (1) and (2) of Regulation 43, the Government of Himachal Pradesh hereby notifies, on and with effect from the date of publication of this Notification in the official Gazette, that-

A Notified Voltage

1. For the purpose of Self-certification under Regulation 30 and 43 of the Central Electricity Authority Regulations, the notified voltage shall be the voltage level of 440 volts.
2. The owner of every electrical installation of the notified voltage and below shall get the installation inspected, tested and self-certified with the assistance of Chartered Electrical safety Engineer before commencement of supply or recommencement after shutdown for six months and above as required by

Regulation 43 of the Central Electricity Authority regulations. The owner shall have to submit the report of certification in the Form I or II, as the case may be , of Schedule IV to the Chief Electrical Inspector. The supplier may commence or recommence supply to such installation on the basis of such self-certification. The owner or supplier or consumer shall also have the option to get such installation inspected, tested and certified by the Chief Electrical Inspector at his discretion.

B Authorization of Chartered Electrical Safety Engineers

1. The Chief Electrical Inspector, Himachal Pradesh, Shimla shall identify the following category of persons to act as Chartered Electrical Safety Engineers in the State of Himachal Pradesh:-

Graduates in Electrical Engineering, who after obtaining degree in Electrical Engineering, have acquired at least 5 years' experience in installation, operation and maintenance of electrical installations as Electrical Engineers and have obtained their Supervisory Competency Certificate from H.P. State Licensing Board.

2. The Chief Electrical Inspector, Himachal Pradesh, Shimla shall submit to the Government within a month from the date of issuance of this Notification, proposal for framing necessary Rules for the purpose of authorization of chartered Electrical Safety Engineer as required under the Central Electricity Authority Regulations.

This Notification shall come into force with immediate effect.
